

Member Story

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When I was a young child, I loved to go visit my maternal grandfather and grandmother, who lived on "The Farm," not far from the small country village in Illinois where I was born and raised. A big part of why I looked forward to visiting "Grandpapa" was because of his wondrous library. He was a retired schoolteacher who had spent his whole teaching career in various one-room schoolhouses in the area.

His library was a small room in which there was a piano, a reading chair, and an ornate standing lamp. The air was filled with the warm pungent scent of his pipe tobacco. But the best things were his books!
